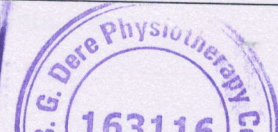

## 1. Purpose

The purpose of the Anti-Ragging Committee is to prevent, prohibit, and eliminate ragging in all forms within the institution, ensuring a safe, respectful, and inclusive academic environment in compliance with the guidelines of the University Grants Commission (UGC).

## 2. Objectives

- To maintain a ragging-free campus.
- To create awareness about the harmful effects of ragging.
- To implement preventive measures.
- To ensure prompt action against reported incidents.
- To protect the dignity and safety of students.

## 3. Scope

This SOP applies to:

- All students (senior and junior)
- Faculty and staff
- Hostel residents
- Visitors within campus premises
- Off-campus locations connected to institutional activities

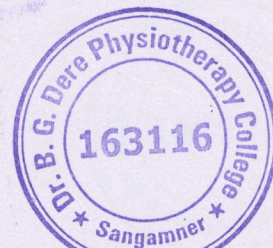
## 4. Definition of Ragging

Ragging includes any act that:

- Causes physical or psychological harm.
- Involves teasing, bullying, humiliation, or harassment.
- Forces a student to perform acts against their will.
- Disrupts academic activities.
- Involves verbal, written, or online abuse.

## 5. Composition of the Anti-Ragging Committee

- Chairperson (Head of Institution/Principal)
- Deputy chairman
- Member Secretary
- UG Co-ordinator
- NGO member
- Representative of Civil administration
- Representative of Police administration
- Office Superintendent
- Rector Boys hostel
- Rector Ladies hostel
- UG Student Representative



- UG Parent Representative

## 6. Roles and Responsibilities

- Chairperson
  - Overall supervision of anti-ragging activities.
  - Ensure implementation of UGC regulations.
  - Approve disciplinary actions.
- Committee Members
  - Monitor campus and hostel activities.
  - Conduct awareness programs.
  - Investigate complaints.
  - Recommend disciplinary actions.
- Student Representatives
  - Act as peer contacts.
  - Promote a positive campus culture.

## 7. Preventive Measures

- Display anti-ragging posters and helpline numbers.
- Conduct orientation programs for freshers and seniors.
- Obtain Anti-Ragging Undertakings from students and parents.
- Surprise checks in hostels and campus.
- Establish a 24/7 complaint helpline/email.

## 8. Complaint Mechanism

### 1. Complaints may be submitted:

- In writing
- Through email
- Via complaint box
- Through helpline

2. Anonymous complaints may be accepted.

3. Immediate safety measures for the victim.

4. Complaint acknowledgment within 24 hours.

### 9. Inquiry Procedure

- Preliminary review within 48 hours.
- Formation of Inquiry Sub-Committee if required.



- Confidential investigation.
- Recording of statements.
- Submission of report within 7 days.

#### 10. Disciplinary Actions

Depending on severity:

- Written warning
- Suspension
- Debarring from classes/exams
- Withholding scholarships
- Expulsion from institution
- Filing FIR with police (if required)

#### 11. Confidentiality

- Protect identity of complainant.
- Maintain records securely.
- No victimization or retaliation.

#### 12. Awareness & Training

- Annual workshops and seminars.
- Counseling sessions.
- Observance of Anti-Ragging Week.

#### 13. Documentation

- Maintain complaint register.
- Keep inquiry reports on record.
- Submit annual compliance report to UGC (if applicable).

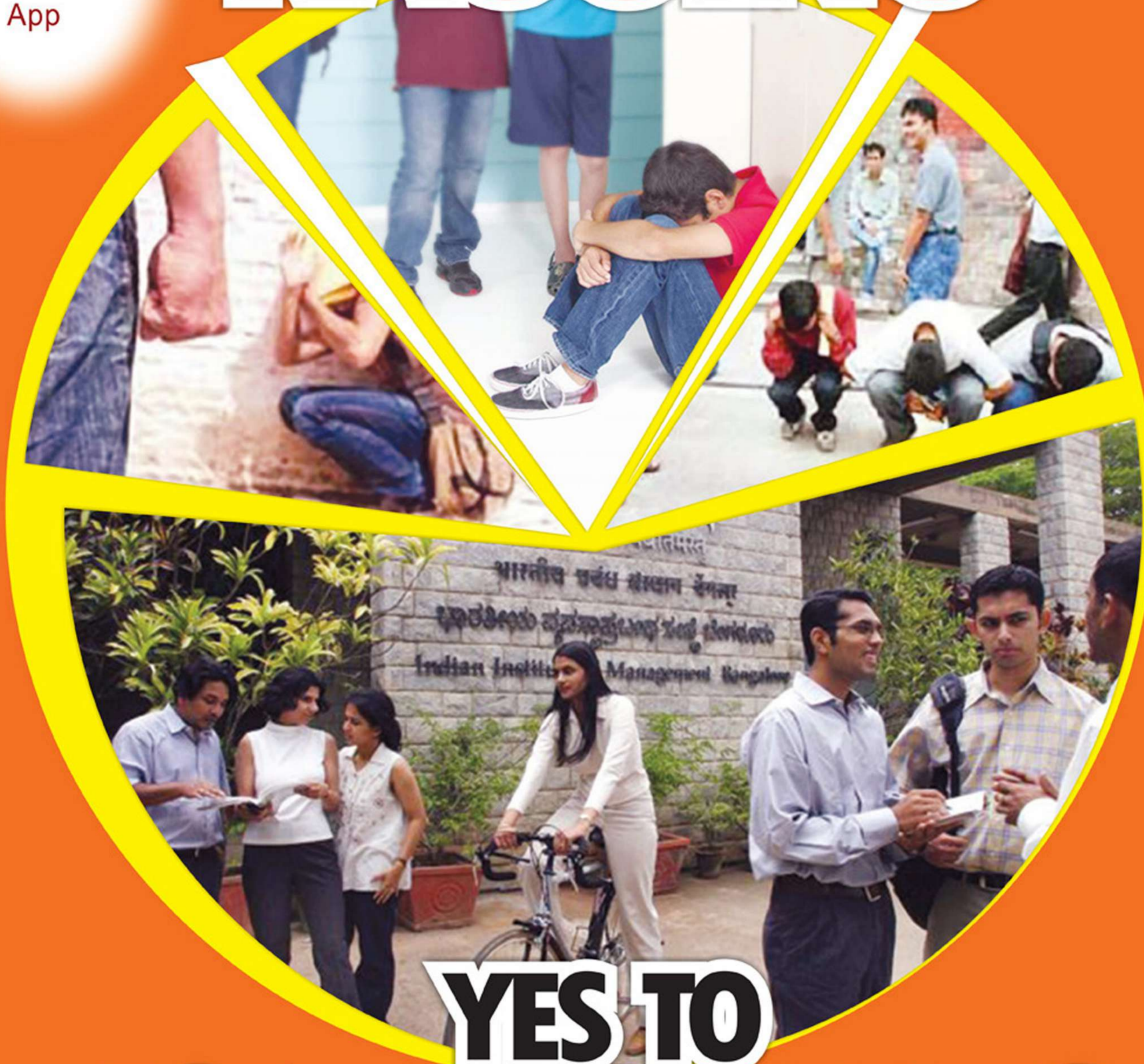

## What is Ragging?

**Any Act Resulting in:**

- Mental/physical/sexual Abuse
- Verbal Abuse
- Indecent Behaviour
- Criminal Intimidation/wrongful Restraint
- Undermining Human Dignity
- Financial Exploitation/extortion
- Use Of Force

### A STUDENT INDULGING IN RAGGING CAN BE:

- Cancellation of admission.
- Suspension from attending classes.
- Withholding/withdrawing Scholarship/Fellowship and other benefits.
- Debarring from appearing in any test/ examination or other evaluation process.
- Withholding results.
- Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament or youth festival etc.
- **Collective punishment** : when the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure community pressure on potential ragger.

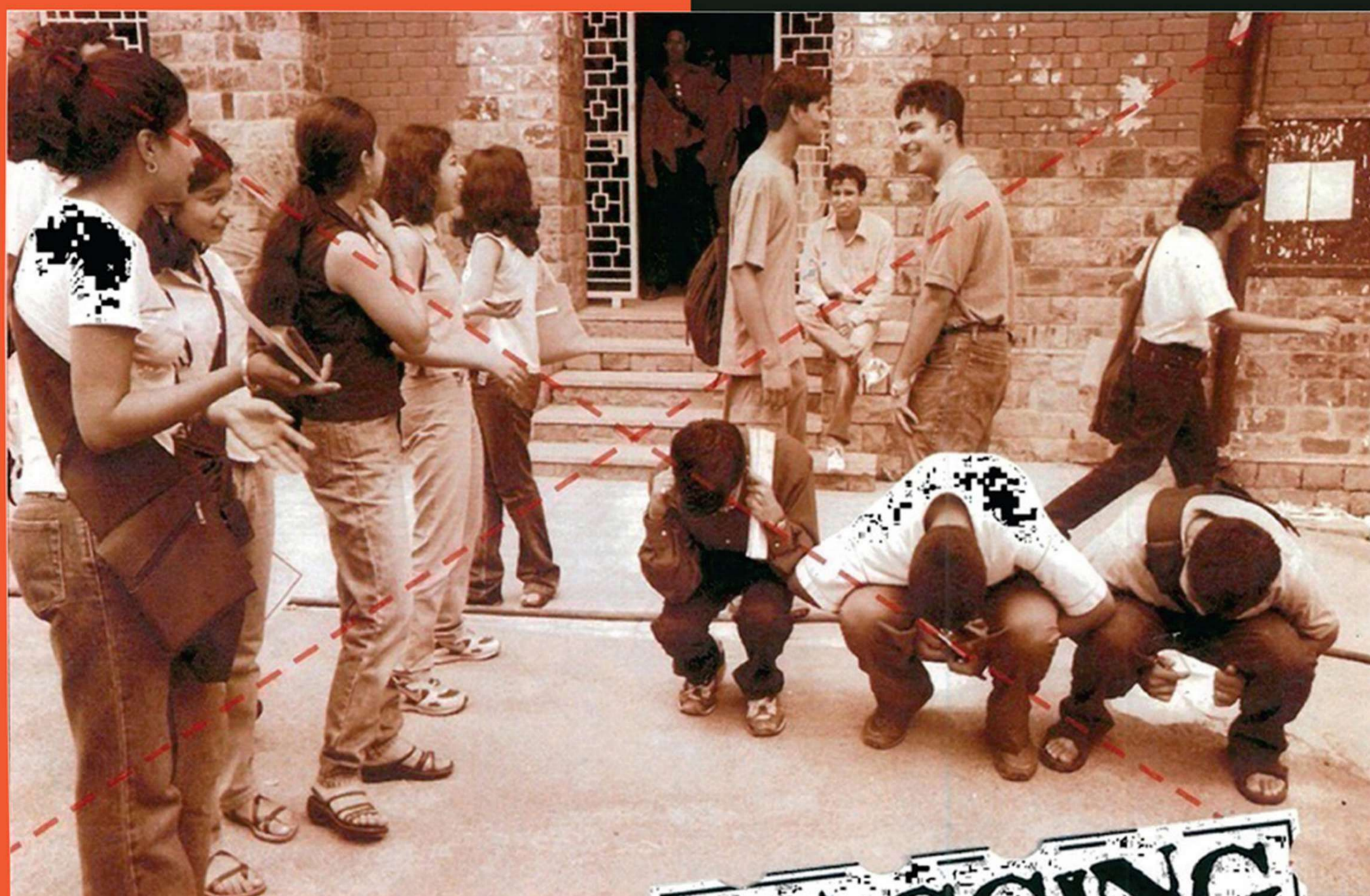
